Global Hunger Affects Over 9% of the World's Population

Global hunger rose sharply from 2019 to 2021 and persisted at the same level to 2023, affecting over 9 percent of the world population in 2023.

According to the United Nations 2024 edition of the State of Food Security and Nutrition in the World report, between 713 and 757 million people faced hunger in 2023—**one out of 11 people in the world, and one out of every five in Africa.**

The report also states, "Apart from hunger, 2.33 billion people experienced moderate or severe food insecurity and 900 million people faced severe food insecurity. Over 3.1 billion people could not afford a healthy diet. Many children under five suffer from malnutrition. Exclusive breastfeeding has improved, but more effort is needed to meet the malnutrition targets by 2030."

With your support, here is how World Vision is making a difference:

- Every month, 2.8 million people receive food assistance from World Vision—more than the population of Vancouver.
- Nearly 10 lives are saved every day through our food assistance programs.
- In 2023, World Vision and the World Food Programme (WFP) distributed 67,690 metric tons of food and provided food assistance to 1,950,835 people. World Vision also partnered with the WFP to provide food to more than 5,000 people displaced by the conflict in Sudan. WV has been the WFP's largest non-governmental partner for over 18 years.

When Nothing Becomes Everything

Abu Ali*, a Syrian refugee, has spent the past 13 years of his life navigating the constant uncertainty of displacement. Forced to flee his home countless times, he endured his last displacement in 2019, escaping a storm of bombs. Now, he and his family reside in a makeshift tent, a fragile shelter from the harsh elements.

Life in the camp is a constant struggle. Abu Ali takes on any work he can find, from farming to construction, to provide for his family. However, the constant threat of hunger looms large. Food insecurity is a daily reality for families like Abu Ali's, leaving them constantly worried about their next meal.

For Abu Ali and other families, these food parcels are not a luxury, but a lifeline. They represent a fragile stability, a bare minimum to survive. "These baskets aren't life-changing," Abu Ali reflects, "but they hold us together. They keep us going."

Living through such challenging conditions, Abu Ali deeply appreciates the support provided. "Thank you from the depths of my heart, and I hope this project continues to support all the people in the camps," he says.




Today's Teens Conference - Feb. 22, 2025, Brampton, ON
